

## SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM



Niagara Region Right to Life is once again offering The Father Ted Colleton Scholarship, based on its mandate to reach society in an educational setting. In particular, Niagara Region Right to Life (NRRTL) wishes to help educate and inform the younger generations about the preciousness and possibilities of human life from conception to natural death. It encourages students to engage critically and meaningfully with key public issues that may impact on human life especially in its early stages.

All grade 11 and 12 students attending a Canadian high school (or who are educated in Canada) are invited to participate in this scholarship.

Three prizes of \$2000, \$1500, and \$1000 will be awarded respectively. Applicants must submit a personal profile, a letter of recommendation, and a 1200-word essay on the topic described below:

Abortion is a hot-button and controversial public issue, generating arguments and justifications from both sides. Analyze the impact of abortion on several key components of the Canadian social fabric, for example: the practice of religious worship; demographic trends and immigration policies; changes in male and female roles and family structure; social cohesion and attitudes with regard to crime and violence; continued economic viability of the country; national unity and cultural character.
